- -One of the biggest differences are the many differences in style and distribution.
- -Most manga are sold either as a tankobun (book) or in a weekly magazine
- -Usually printed in black and white and are fairly clunky, almost like a digest.
- -American comics are distributed and styled in a different way.
- -American comic books are usually sold as magazines (est 32 pages) with colored print.





- -Japanese Manga tend to have longer stories compared to their American counterparts.
- -American Comic Books like Marvel or DC have a shared universe between all their heroes.
- -Japanese Manga only have one author whereas numerous people work on comics











MANGA: GENRE AND RATINGS

  - Ex: Naruto- Action, Comedy, Martial Arts, Shounen






## MYSTERY





- → Not really targeted for any gender or age group

## SPORTS


- → Covers many sports

- → Ex: Haikyuu
  - ◆ Genre: Sport, Shounen, Comedy, Drama, School
- → Ex:Kuroko no Basket
  - Genre: Sport, Shounen,School, Comedy








## SCHOOL



- → A genre that is mostly targeted for teenagers
- → Manga's for both genders
- → Ex:Ouran Highschool
  Host Club
  - Genre: School, Shoujo, Comedy, Romance, Drama
- → Ex:Assassination Classroom
  - Genre: School, Shounen, Comedy, Action

# SHOUNEN AND SHOUJO

- → Shoujo
  - Targeted for teenage girls
  - ♦ Age group: 10-18
- → Ex: Skip Beat
  - ◆ Genre: Shoujo, Comedy, Slice of life, Drama
- → Shounen
  - Targeted for teenage boys
  - ♦ Age groups: 10-18
- → Ex: Fairy Tail
  - Genre: Shounen, Action, Comedy, Fantasy, etc.







## SEINEN AND JOSEI



- ◆ Targeted for Adult men
- ◆ Age group: 18-40
- → Ex: Tokyo Ghoul
  - Genre: Seinen, Psychological,
     Supernatural, etc.
- → Josei
  - ◆ Targeted for Adult women
  - ◆ Age group: 18-40
- → Ex: Nana
  - ◆ Genre: Josei, Romance, Slice of life, Music, Drama

# MANGA MAGAZINES





## EXAMPLES:

#### Weekly Shonen Jump

- Weekly shonen magazine
- Best selling manga magazine and one of longest running
- First release in 1968
- Titles like One Piece and Hunter x Hunter







## EXAMPLES CON.

#### Nakayoshi

- Monthly shojo magazine
- Includes small gifts
- First release in 1954
- Titles like Cardcaptor
   Sakura and Sailor Moon







## EXAMPLES CON.

#### Weekly Young Jump

- Weekly seinen manga
- First release in 1979
- Titles like Kingdom and Tokyo Ghoul







## EXAMPLES CON.

#### Be Love

- Monthly josei magazine
- Leading manga magazine for a women
- First release in 1980
- Titles like Peach Girl and Chihayafuru





## WHY MAGAZINES:

- More genre focused
- Not really same in other places
- Online vs. Hardcopy
- Different layout
- Translated
- Individual not anthology

## B&W VS COLOR

- ❖ Printing B&W is cheaper
- While it's B&W, the artist can really use a variety of shadow techniques
- It gives a unique feeling to the reader
- The production length varies
  - some artist barely make the
    quota

- Requires more time to produce
  - It will be more difficult for some artist
- ❖ Gives a different vibe
  - ➤ Especially if it's digital
- Printing in Color is more
  expensive
  - Only popular manga get some color printings, if they have funds for it
