





Theme park related goods






Day 4 Shizuoka-Yamanashi Prefecture

Mt. Fuji

- Japan's most HIGHEST mountain.
 - Active Volcano, Last eruption 1707
 - Famous Landmark.
- Start at 7:30pm at 5th station (night of Day 3)
- 6 hours up and 4 hours down.
 Station 5 to 6= 30 minutes
 Station 6 to 7= 60 minutes
 Station 7 to 8= 100 minutes
 Station 8 to top= 160 minutes
- Mountain Hut 2:30am REST
- Drink Hot tea and Ramen
- Wake up to reach top peak around 4am.











Sunrise at Mt Fuji




